

England name squad for EU Nations Water Polo Tournament

England have selected a strong senior squad for the EU Nations Water Polo Tournament in the Czech Republic.

Coach Tim Dunsbee is taking 15 players to Prague for the event, which takes place from 18-20 May.

Skipped by London 2012 Olympian Rob Parker, England have been drawn in Group B and face Switzerland, hosts Czech Republic, Denmark and Lithuania.

Their first match is on Friday at 11.30am against Switzerland and they will then take on the Czech Republic at 5.45pm.
