Swim England Level Two qualified teachers and coaches can take the RLSS UK's Rookie Lifeguard Instructor course for a special reduced price of £10.

It is one of a number of upskilling opportunities that will be created by the partnership in the coming months.

The Rookie Lifeguard Programme teaches children valuable water safety and lifesaving skills in a fun way.

Katie Towner, Swim England Head of Learn to Swim, said: "The Rookie Lifeguard programme is about extending the skills and abilities of young swimmers, helping them to be aware of how to avoid dangers and enjoy the water safely. The Award is also a comfort to parents to know that their children understand how to be safe in the water.
